STEPS TO BE TAKEN

1. Students must meet with an Academic Advisor: In order to obtain registration clearance, Deree College students who have completed form 0 to 50 credits and all Junior College students must be individually advised by members of the Academic Advising Office on their respective campus. To schedule an appointment with an Academic Advisor, please call extensions 1431 (APC) or 2408 and 2541 (DTC).
2. Deree College students with 51 credits or more are strongly encouraged to schedule an advising session with a designated faculty member of their academic major.
3. Deree and Junior College students on Academic Probation must meet with an Academic Advisor in order to obtain registration clearance. Obtaining Academic Advising clearance is mandatory for students to have access to online registration.
4. Meet all obligations:
 - a. Business office: pay outstanding balance and deposit (a week before registration), APC ext. 1404, DTC ext. 2407
 - b. Clear Library Obligations

7. Late Registration: Students, who fail to register within the specified period (July 5, 2010 - Sept. 6, 2010), will be allowed to register only during Late registration (Sept. 7, 2010) and they will be charged a late registration fee.
