

**DEREE COLLEGE SYLLABUS FOR: AT 4034 TOPICS IN MEDIEVAL ART**

**PREREQUISITES:**

None

**CATALOG DESCRIPTION:**

In-depth investigation of a topic in the study of medieval art. The topic is chosen in advance.

**RATIONALE:**

The topic of this seminar course will allow students to focus on a particular issue in the study of medieval art, and enable them to build on previous learning.

**LEARNING OUTCOMES:**

As a result of taking this course, the student should be able to:

1. Demonstrate ability to undertake independent research, including both secondary and primary scholarly sources (where applicable);
2. Critically analyse scholarly sources;
3. Construct an argument, demonstrating in-depth understanding of the scholarly debates related to the specific topic.

**METHOD OF TEACHING AND LEARNING:**

In congruence with the teaching and learning strategy of the college, the following tools are used:

1. Classes consist of lectures accompanied by visuals, and class discussion.
2. Use of field trips when possible.
3. Office hours: students are encouraged to make full use of the office hours of their instructor, where they can ask questions and go over lecture material.
4. Use of a Blackboard site, where instructors post assignment instructions, timely announcements, as well as additional resources.
5. Use of library facilities: students are encouraged to make use of the library facilities for their assignments as well as for preparation for the exams.
