CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

Dance pedagogy methods and concepts. Planning, management of the 'real time' dynamics of a class. Principles of the learning-teaching dynamic. Facilitation of dance activity in community settings. Facilitation of dance projects for under-served communities. Involving target participants in project planning

RATIONALE:

The course will offer students –many of whom will have to complement their performance careers with teaching- knowledge of methodologies for facilitating dance projects in a variety of settings: secondary school, community, and special populations. Students will gain an understanding of professional opportunities in the field of teaching dance in non-dance specialist contexts.

1. Analyze and apply methods of classroom/group management and their effectiveness in a variety of settings.
2. Analyze and apply evaluation tools in the assessment of student learning in a variety of settings.

4. Apply specific teaching methods for different types of dance for specific populations.
5. Develop strategies for career success as a facilitator of dance in a variety of contexts.
