CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

Self-directed mode of choreographic work with tutor and peer support. Students create an extended piece of choreography in order to build on, consolidate and elaborate knowledge and skills gained throughout the choreography courses. The work will be developed with mentor support to performance level in showcase conditions. Preparation to professional practice.

RATIONALE:

Students work autonomously in a self-directed mode. It is particularly designed to give students in their final year experience in choreography within industry standards and structures that prepares them for transition to professional work and/or graduate studies. Experience in 'free-lance'/entrepreneurial work contexts.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

As a result of taking this course, the student should be able to:

- 1. Design and undertake the making of an extensive piece of choreography from rehearsals to theatre performance.
- 2. Apply rigour in their capacity to work independently through the application of various techniques in order to consolidate a working method.
- 3. Demonstrate ability to reflect in order to develop as an artist and a person.
- 4. Demonstrate an insight into the context of their work.
- 5. Defend and elaborate their concepts in dialogue with others as part of the creative process.
