



AGREEMENT, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND RELEASE FORM

The American College of Greece The National Hellenic Society, Inc.

THIS IS A RELEASE OF LEGAL RIGHTS—
READ AND UNDERSTAND BEFORE SIGNING

Whereas the undersigned Student Participant ("Student") has been accepted to participate in the Heritage Greece Program ("Program") for the period of June 11th, 2010 through June 25th, 2010.

Whereas, ACG has established the following terms and conditions for the Student's participation in the Program.

Student agrees that participation in the Program is wholly voluntary. In consideration of the ACG's and Sponsors agreement to allow Student to participate in the Program, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Student agrees as follows:

1. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: THE STUDENT UNDERSTANDS THAT THIS AGREEMENT SETS FORTH ALL THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM AND FURTHER UNDERSTANDS THAT THIS AGREEMENT CONTAINS A WAIVER OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF GREECE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, THE NATIONAL HELLENIC SOCIETY, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS AND STAFF, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS, SERVANTS AND EMPLOYEES.

THE STUDENT ACKNOWLEDGES, BY THE SIGNATURE BELOW, THEY HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS, THAT THEY FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, THAT THEY AGREE TO ABIDE BY ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS AN EXPRESS CONDITION OF PARTICIPATION IN THE HERITAGE GREECE PROGRAM, AND THAT NO ORAL REPRESENTATIONS, STATEMENTS OR INDUCEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE REGARDING THE AGREEMENT AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS. STUDENT FURTHER REPRESENTS THAT THEY ARE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND FULLY COMPETENT TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.

2. Risks of International Travel. The Student understands that participation in the Heritage Greece Program and in international travel involves risks. These include without limitation risks involved in travelling to and within, and returning from, international locations such as Greece; foreign, political, legal, medical, social, and economic conditions; different standards of design, safety and maintenance of buildings, public places and conveyances; and local weather conditions. The health and safety standards may be substantially below those enjoyed in the United States, and the Student recognizes that they may be subjected to potential risks, illnesses, injuries and even death. The student has made their own independent investigation of these risks, understands these risks, and assumes these risks knowingly, willingly and voluntarily.

The Student acknowledges that while participating in the Heritage Greece Program, there is a possibility the Student may experience such problems as increased crime, pollution, traffic hazards, terrorism, population density and standards of living and health standards that are not equivalent to those in the United States. The Student will exercise every precaution to safeguard their respect health, protect there personal property from damage or theft and avoid unnecessary risks that endanger their person.

The Student acknowledges that they have read and understood the U.S. Department of State Consular Information Sheet on Greece (available on the U.S. Department of State website: http://travel.state.gov/travel/cis pa tw/cis/cis 1127.html) and fully understands and assumes the risks and assumes the same knowingly, willingly and voluntarily.

- 2. Program Information. The Heritage Greece Program is generally described in the literature provided to the Student and available online at: http://www.acg.edu. It is understood and agreed that the information contained therein is descriptive only and may be changed in the discretion of the ACG which reserves the right to make Program changes at any time and for any reason, with or without notice. ACG and/or the Sponsor shall not be liable to the Student because of any such change. ACG reserves all rights, in its sole discretion, to cancel the Program or any aspect thereof prior to or after departure, and in the case of cancellation after departure, to require the Student to return to the United States, if ACG determines or believes it is in the best interests of the Student.
- 3. Payment of Fees, Tuition. The Sponsor agrees to pay the required fees, tuition, accommodations, meals, and transportation costs to from and within Greece from the central disembarking location of New York (John F. Kennedy Airport). Student acknowledges and agrees to pay for all other costs. The Student agrees that ACG and/or the Sponsor shall not be held responsible or liable for the loss, damage, destruction, or theft of the Student's luggage, personal belongings, or for any other injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or expense arising out of such matters. The ACG and Sponsor recommend the Student purchase necessary insurance to safeguard against these risks.

- 4. Activities. ACG and/or the Sponsor are not responsible for any claims that may arise because of the Student becoming separated from the Program group, failing to meet a departure bus, airplane, train, or becomes sick or injured. The Student at their own expense will seek out, contact and reach the Program group as soon as and where practicable.
- 5. Sponsor Held Harmless and Indemnified. The Sponsor has no involvement, control, or authority in selecting the staff, route, schedule, transportation, facilities, equipment, itinerary, activities, and schedule related to the Program. The Sponsor shall not be responsible for the action, inaction, omission, or commission of ACG staff members, other Student participants, third parties. The Student agrees that the Sponsor shall be held harmless, and agrees to indemnify the Sponsor for any and all claims that may arise out of the Student's participation in the Heritage Greece Program.
- 6. Compliance with Laws, Rules and Regulations.
 - A. Student shall comply with all rules, regulations, and standards of conduct established by the ACG, as well as the laws, regulations, ordinances and standards of conduct of Greece. The Student understands that violation of applicable rules, regulations, and standards of conduct, laws, regulations, ordinances and standards of conduct mandated by Greece may result in disciplinary action, including suspension and expulsion from the Program as well as possible prosecution by the Greek authorities. In the event that a violation results in suspension or expulsion from the Program, ACG reserves the right to require that the Student return to the United States. The Student shall be responsible and obligated to pay any and all expenses incurred as a consequence of such disciplinary action. The Student shall also be responsible and obligated to pay any and all expenses incurred as a consequence of any civil, criminal or similar prosecution brought by the Greek authorities and/or any third party. The ACG and National Hellenic Society shall not be responsible for providing any assistance to the Student under such circumstances.
 - B. the Student understands and agrees: (1) the American College of Greece and the National Hellenic Society are distinct and separate entities; (2) the American College of Greece and the National Hellenic Society are not partners, co-venturers, or business associates. The National Hellenic Society is a non-profit, charitable organization that is solely providing a scholarship grant to Student to attend the Heritage Greece Program; and (3) ACG's staff, employees, and/or agents are not the staff, employees, and/or agents of the National Hellenic Society
- 7. Medical Condition. Student represents, and has provided documentation that they have been examined by a licensed physician, that they have provided the physician all relevant information about the Program, itinerary and schedule of events and activities, for the physician to make a sound determination as to whether the Student is in good health for purposes of participation in the Program. The Student has no

apparent physical or and/or mental condition which may require medical, surgical or other care or treatment, or which will, to a reasonable degree of medical probability, require such care or treatment during the Student's participation in the Program.

8. Health Insurance. The Student assumes responsibility for medical treatment and the costs of such treatment while participating in the Program. The Student represents warrants and shall produce documentation evidencing medical insurance coverage throughout the Program and throughout Student's absence from the United States. Medical insurance coverage must provide for emergency medical care, treatment, hospitalization, medicine, and physician and medical care provider care charges in Greece, as well as insurance for medical evacuation and repatriation expenses. By the Student's signature below, Student certifies that their healthy insurance policy will adequately provide this coverage outside the United States; and herby releases and discharges the American College of Greece, and the National Hellenic Society of all responsibility and liability for any injuries, illnesses, claims, damages, charges, bills and/or expenses the Student may incur while abroad.

9. Waiver of Claims.

A. The American College of Greece offers this Program to broaden Student's education, appreciation of Hellenic values, ideals and culture. The Student understands that there are risks incident to travelling abroad and visiting a foreign country, including but not limited to, travelling to and within, and returning from, one or more foreign countries; foreign political, legal, social, economic conditions; the risk of terrorism; different standards of design, safety, and maintenance of buildings, public places, and conveyances; and local medical, weather, geological conditions. Student understands, acknowledges and is aware of and understands these risk and dangers of travel to, from, in and around Greece including but not limited to the dangers to Student's own health, personal safety and possible property damage and or loss. Student hereby assumes, knowingly and voluntarily, each of these risks and all of the other risks which could arise out of or occur during travel to, from, in and around Greece. Student further understands, agrees that the American College of Greece and the National Hellenic Society, their respective trustees, board of directors, officers, staff, agents, servants, employees (collectively, the "Releasees") shall not be liable for:

- 1. any injury, damage, accident or other loss caused by the acts or omissions of the Releasees, or any third party provider of services on behalf of the Releasees;
- 2. any injury damage, accident(s) or other loss due to events beyond its control, including, but not limited to, acts of God, strikes, hostilities, weather, force majeure, war, quarantine, civil unrest, public health risks, criminal activity, terrorism, or politically motivated violence;
- 3. any delay, disruption or modification of travel arrangements, schedule, agenda, itinerary, or loss, expense caused by such delay, disruption, modification or otherwise.

- 4. any injury, damage, accident or other loss that arises as a result of the Student's failure to comply with instructions, standards, rules, laws; and,
- 5. any sickness, disease, injuries (including death), damage, accident or other loss occurring while travelling both in the United States and abroad.
- B. Student individually and on behalf of Student's heirs, assigns, personal representative(s), executors and otherwise, releases and forever discharges the Releasees from and against any and all liability for any harm, injury, damage, claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses of any nature whatsoever, which arise out of, occur during, or are in any way related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death), sustained by Student or caused to Student's person and/or property, while Student is participating in the Program or any travel incident thereto.
- C. Student agrees to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify the National Hellenic Society, Inc., its directors, officers, staff, representatives, agents, employees, from and against any present or future claim, loss or liability for injury to person or property which Student may suffer, or for which Student may be liable to any other person, entity, related to Student's participation in the Program (including periods in transit to, from, within, any destination), resulting from any cause, including but not limited to ordinary or gross negligence. Student agrees to indemnify the National Hellenic Society for all costs, expenses and defense including attorney fees for any present or future claim arising under and out of Student's participation in the Program.
- 10. Governing Law; Forum. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Delaware. All claims arising under and/or out of this Agreement and/or from the Student's participation in the Program shall be resolved by binding arbitration by a panel of three arbitrators under the Rules of the American Arbitration Association in the State of Delaware. The terms of this Agreement shall be severable, if any portion is deemed to be illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with Delaware Law which shall govern this Agreement, the validity of the remaining portion shall not be thereby affected.
