Happy New Year DEREЕ sports fans! We know you're eager to catch up on the latest losses and wins, so here goes!

- ✓ **Men's Soccer:** The Men's Soccer team continued their winning streak with a 5-1 win over *Solon* on December 8th, a 4-1 win over *IBM* on December 17th, and a 3-1 win over *Anagennisi Galatsiou* on January 9th. Way to go boys! This is their ninth win out of the twelve games played thus far. They currently rank second in the Commercial Super League Championship.
- ✓ **Women's Volleyball:** The Women's Volleyball team played a great game on December 12th against *Daphni-Ag. Dimitriou* and won 3-2. They went on to win another game on January 9th when they played *A.E.S.A.F. Kouros* and managed to beat their opponents 3-0. Coach Tilelis comments: "The girls, despite minor set-backs due to injuries, were able to play an impressive game and win all three sets. I'm proud of them".
- ✓ **Women's Basketball:** On December 12th our Women's Basketball team went up against the highly experienced team of *GS Ilioupolis* and despite their ability to keep the score close in the first quarter with team unity and good defense, fatigue and bad judgment gave their opponents the opportunity to take the game by a wide margin (74-42). They were faced with another challenge when they went up against *G.S. Koropiou* and despite an impressive first quarter, lost the game 32-53.
