Eight teams participating in two divisions of four (win=2 points, loss=1 point, forfeit=0 points). After divisional Round Robin play, the winners of each division play those finished second in the other; the winners will play in the Final and the losing teams in the 3rd place game.

TIES: in Round Robin competition if two teams have the same number of points, the winner of the game played between them will place higher. If more teams are tied, the team with the most points in the games played between them will place higher. If the teams remain tied additional criteria will be: the higher difference between the total offense and defence, more total points scored.

#### **RULES OF COMPETITION**

The winner team will be determined by the best out of three sets.

Each set is 25 points / Tie-break is 15 points.

Two time-outs per team per set.

Every team will have 10 minutes for warm up.

Teams must be present 30' prior to game time. If a game is delayed more than 10', the team that caused the delay shall forfeit the game.

Seven teams participating in two divisions of three and four (2-0 win=3 points, 2-1 win=2 points, 1-2 loss=1 point, 0-2 loss=0 points, forfeit=0 points / 0-25,0-25). After divisional Round Robin play, the winners of each division play those finished second in the other; the winners will play in the Final and the losing teams in the 3rd place game. Those finished 3rd in divisional round robin play will play in the 5th place game.

TIES: in Round Robin competition if two teams have the same number of points, the winner of the game played between them will place higher. If more teams are tied, the team with the most points in the games played between them will place higher. If the teams remain tied additional criteria will be: the higher difference between the total sets won and lost, the higher difference between the points won and lost, more total points scored.

All other rules will follow FIVB guidelines.

### **RULES OF COMPETITION**

Each game will be 2X35' with a 5' halftime break; warm-up will be 10'.

Each team can substitute up to 7 players.

Teams must be present 30' prior to game time. If a game is delayed more than 10', the team that caused the delay shall forfeit the game.

A player misses next game after receiving 1 red card.

All players must wear shin-guards and plastic-cleats shoes for artificial turf.

Six teams participating in two divisions of four and three (win=3 points, tie=1 point, loss=0 points, forfeit = 0 points /0-3). After divisional Round Robin play, the winners of each division play those finished second in the other; the winners will play in the Final and the losing teams in the 3rd place game. Those finished 3rd in divisional round robin play will play in the 5th place game.

In case of a tie in the Final or the 3rd/5th place game, there will be no extra-time, but penalty kicks (5 for each team, and if needed more 1 for each team).

TIES: in Round Robin competition if two teams have the same number of points, the winner of the game played between them will place higher. If more teams are tied, the team with the most points in the games played between them will place higher. If the teams remain tied, additional criteria will be: the higher difference between the total offense and defense, more total goals scored, fewer red cards, fewer yellow cards.

All other rules will follow FIFA guidelines.

Artificial turf - only shoes with plastic cleats allowed.

A player misses next game after receiving 1 red card.

All players must wear shin-guards, and appropriate rubber footwear.

Four teams will play in Round Robin competition with first through fourth place determined by most total points (win=3 points, tie=1 point, loss=0 points, forfeit=0 points /0-3).

TIES: in Round Robin competition if two teams have the same number of points, the winner of the game played between them will place higher. If more teams are tied, the team with the most points in the games played between them will place higher. If the teams remain tied additional criteria will be: the higher difference between the total offense and defense, more total goals scored.

All other rules will follow FIFA Futsal guidelines.

Each game will be 4X12' running time, with a 1' break & 3' halftime break. Warm-up will be 10' Teams must be present 30' prior to game time. If a game is delayed more than 10', the team that caused the delay shall forfeit the game.

Four teams will play in Round Robin competition with first through fourth place determined by most total points (win = 3 points, tie = 1 point, loss = 0 points, forfeit = 0 points  $\neq 0.5$ ).

TIES: in Round Robin competition if two teams have the same number of points, the winner of the game played between them will place higher. If more teams are tied, the team with the most points in the games played between them will place higher. If the teams remain tied additional criteria will be: the higher difference between the total offense and defense, more total goals scored.

All other rules will follow FINA guidelines.

The swim competition will be held in the 50m outdoor pool of the American College of Greece.

There is no limit on the swim entrees per event from each University, although only the top two times of each team will be considered in the teams' total point score, and will be eligible to receive a medal if they place in the top-3 of the event.

Each swimmer can participate in a maximum of four (4) events + relays, and no more than two (2) in the same day.

The competition will adhere to FINA swimming rules.

The top three (3) winners of each event will receive medals.

Electronic timekeeping will be used in the competition.

A trophy will be awarded to the top three (3) teams in men's and women's standings, according to the points listed below; points in relay events count double:

1st = 10 points, 2nd = 7 points, 3rd = 6 points, 4th = 5 points, 5th = 4 points, 6th = 3 points, 7th = 2 points, 8th = 1 point.

#### **RULES OF COMPETITION**

The tennis tournament will be held at the Deree tennis courts of the American College of Greece.

The tournament sign-in will take place on Wednesday, April 10 at 10:00, and the matches will start immediately after the sign in.

The players are responsible to be there when they are being called for their matches.

The schedule of the matches and the approximate times of their match will be announced after the sign in.

In case of a player delaying more than 10' the player being present will be awarded the winner.

#### SCORE IN A SET

1. "SHORT" SETS

The first player who wins four games wins that set, provided there is a margin of two games over the opponent.

If the score reaches four games all, a tie-break game shall be played.

The winner is the player who wins two "short" sets.

2. MATCH TIE-BREAK (10 POINTS)

When the score in a match is one set all, one 10-point tie-break game shall be played to decide the winner.

This tie-break game replaces the deciding final set.

The player who first wins ten points shall win this match tie-break and the match, provided there is a margin of two points over the opponent.

During the tie-break, the players switch ends of the court after every six points are played.

All other rules will follow the International Tennis Federation (I.T.F.) guidelines.
