

100 Years of Excellence

ACG's Centennial Gala at Athens Concert Hall in December was a dazzling tribute to our institution's 100 years of profound impact in Greece. **The Centennial Fund** raised \$1.6M, exceeding our goal and helping pave the way for ACG's next century of excellence through support for student scholarships, new educational programs and faculty development. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to the **many generous benefactors** who supported the Centennial Fund in honor of ACG's century of impact.



Alums awarded during the Centennial Gala, from left to right: The Arts & Culture award was presented to **Sophia Kalogeropoulou** (Pierce '64), while the Business Awards were bestowed upon **Elena Chouliara** (Alba '01), **Nelly Katsou** (Pierce '83), **Vassilios Katsos** (Pierce '91), and **Nikos Koumettis** (Deree '86). **Barbara Geladakis**, MD (Pierce '95) received the Education & Science award, and the Social Impact award was granted to **Vana Lavidas** (Pierce '79) and **Lena Papalexopoulou** (Pierce '82). The pinnacle of recognition was reserved for **Athina Martinou** (Pierce'45), and her son, **Thanasis Martinos**, who graciously accepted the prestigious Maria West Lifetime Achievement award on behalf of his mother. The award statues were created by sculptor **Athena Politopoulou-Kargsten** (Pierce '56 & '57).

ACG entered into a new partnership with the **Charles Antetokounmpo Family Foundation,** established by the family of champion Greek-Nigerian NBA players. The new partnership includes educational programming at Pierce for 100 under-resourced youth participating in the foundation's AntetokounBros Academy scholarships for AntetokounBros Academy graduates to attend Deree. CAFF is also joining the U.S. Embassy Athens and Kosmo Kalliarekos in generously contributing to Greece's only university-based, comprehensive scholarship program for refugee students, Education Unites ACG. The program provides scholarships for 40 refugee students from the Middle East, Africa and Ukraine each year.

"We created the Charles Antetokounmpo Family Foundation to honor our father Charles, who taught us that each of us has a responsibility to help others achieve their dreams. Viva.com, a Greek start-up and the first European entirely cloud-based neobank, stepped forward with a generous first-time gift to ACG. Viva.com's \$125K gift supports three programs aligned with the company's priorities: scholarships for Deree students studying entrepreneurship management, management information systems, Information Technology and Cybersecurity and Networks; scholarships for Deree students to study abroad; and The Pierce Innovation and Entrepreneurship Academy Powered by Viva.com.

Groundbreaking Partnerships

A generous Greek family foundation's \$25K arant award supported interdisciplinary team from history, visual culture, design studies and digital humanities to meet the demands of studying tourism and nation branding in Greece. The project provides a resource on the history of Greek tourism from the perspective of the and government, private transnational stakeholders who created the image of Greece and made the nation a highly popular tourism destination.



Helidoni Foundation

The Helidoni Foundation supported ACG's role in The Lesvos Mission Blue Project in 2023, promoting the conservation of the Mission Blue Avlaki Hope Spot on Lesvos in partnership with the nonprofit Healing Lesvos and The University of the Aegean. The project set up a prototype of best practices that can be adopted by other islands or regions in Greece and the Mediterranean, with an emphasis on environmental conservation through the engagement of youth and empowerment of the most vulnerable social groups, such as refugees.



The President's Circle

The President's Circle sets the standard for philanthropic commitment to ACG with annual gifts of \$1,875-plus, symbolizing ACG's founding in 1875. This distinguished group of individuals, companies and foundations gathered on campus in January for updates on ACG's growth and impact from President David G. Horner. Alba MBA student and scholarship recipient Tasos Ntaskas balances his studies with a finance position at General Mills and inspired the crowd with gratitude for the scholarship support that has made his academic and professional career possible.

"I like to dream my journey might lead me to become a CFO, a CEO or to embark on my own venture, but the truth is I don't know how my path will unfold," Tasos said. "What I do know is that one of the catalysts towards this future will be the Alba MBA experience, which I wouldn't be able to afford without your help." — Tasos Ntaskas, Alba '23

2023 Campaigns

- 1. **Annual Fund**: Seventy-seven donors contributed to the 2023 Annual Fund, raising \$39K to support scholarships for promising students with financial need. The majority of all ACG students received financial aid in 2023.
- 2. Take-a-Seat: The campaign to support the East Campus and Aghia Paraskevi Stadiums raised more than \$98K from 101 generous families and UBITECH, supporting operations and maintenance of the stadiums.
- 3. More than 393 Pierce alumni and 194 Deree alumni contributed to ACG's Scholarship Fund through purchase of 2023 Reunion Homecoming tickets.

Beyond the Degree: Evaluating ACG's Impact on the Lives of Alumni

At The American College of Greece, we believe the institution's most significant contribution is long-term investments in human capital so that 67,000+ alumni generate critical social and economic impact in Greece and globally. To test this belief and better understand the long-term impacts of ACG on the lives of alumni, we conducted a comprehensive year-long research project in collaboration with the independent market research firm MindSearch. The study involved over 550 alumni representing diverse ages, professions, and backgrounds through focus groups, interviews, and phone surveys. The aim was to understand the unique ways in which ACG has influenced the lives of its alumni, how it stands apart within the educational ecosystem, and how we can improve.



Key Findings:

- 90% of alumni rank ACG at the top of the scale for high academic standards and, diversity of educational experience
- 90% say the ACG experience prepared them with the hard and soft skills they need to step into the workforce, be competitive, and grow as professionals.
- ACG alumni are entrepreneurial. 38% report they are either business owners or self-employed professionals compared to Greece's 32% national average.

PIERCE IMPACT

PIERCE HAS BEEN A MODEL OF EDUCATIONAL VISION AND EXCELLENCE SINCE ITS FOUNDING AS A SCHOOL FOR ARMENIAN, GREEK, JEWISH AND TURKISH GIRLS IN SMYRNA/IZMIR IN 1875. WITH THE ADDITION OF A PRESCHOOL, KINDERGARTEN AND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO ITS OUTSTANDING CO-EDUCATIONAL SECONDARY OFFERINGS, PIERCE IS SETTING ITSELF APART EVEN MORE.

Pierce Parents Fundraising Committee Pierce parents have generously stepped up to support the school with the launch of the elementary school and ongoing relocation of Pierce upper grades to the Spata Campus. Over the last five years, total giving by Pierce parents has increased by 265% to \$270K, supporting student scholarships and programs. The Pierce Parents Fundraising Committee launched in 2023 with the goal of building a culture of philanthropy within the Pierce parent community.

Pierce parent **Mark Sigalas and his family** are supporting the Pierce Innovation Academy through their company Omnium. Their generous gift of €10K supported the 3rd Panhellenic Racecar Competition, the purchase of robotics and Racecar Competition equipment, and tools for technology courses, such as pyrographs.



Zephyros Maritime Company made a €10K commitment to fund the first maritime academy for elementary school students at Pierce Elementary School. The gift from Zephyros was spearheaded by Pierce parent, Theodoros Zografos, Managing Zephyros Maritime. Launched with financial support from Lloyd's Register Foundation under the auspices of ACG's Center of Excellence Logistics, Shipping in Transportation, the Pierce Maritime Academy's mission is to inspire the next generation of maritime professionals from an early age through experiential learning.

DEREE IMPACT

AS DEREE'S ENROLLMENT GROWS STEADILY, REACHING 4,500 UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDENTS FROM MORE THAN 70 COUNTRIES IN 2023, WE REMAIN DEEPLY COMMITTED TO MEETING THE NEEDS OF OUR DIVERSE STUDENT BODY, 56% OF WHOM RECEIVE FINANCIAL AID OR SCHOLARSHIPS. PHILANTHROPIC SUPPORT FOR THESE STUDENTS IS CRUCIAL TO PRESERVING OUR MISSION AND SUSTAINING OUR IMPACT.

ACG Former Trustee Kosmo Kalliarekos' generous gift of \$100K over four years supports Education Unites, ACG's scholarship program for refugee, migrant and displaced students. We're grateful for the contribution, the first from an individual in support of Education Unites, matching a 2022 grant from the U.S. Embassy in Athens. Education Unites provides scholarships for 40 refugee students from the Middle East, Africa and Ukraine at ACG annually.

The **Nicholas J. and Anna K. Bouras Foundation**, based in Summit, New Jersey, awarded ACG \$100K to support need-based scholarships for U.S. students pursuing their degrees at Deree.

Our gratitude to **ACG Trustee Alex Aldous**, Pierce '98, for his gift of \$60K for The Aldous Family Accessibility Scholarship, support over six years for an entering Deree student who is legally blind. The gift honors Aldous' mother, Dr. Eleftheria Bernidaki-Aldous a Pierce 1970 alumna and former Deree Professor Emeritus, who is blind.



Henry Luce Foundation made a first-time award to ACG of \$100K to partner with the nonprofit Epistimi to provide leadership development scholarships for 25 early-career women in STEMM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math and Medicine.) Epistimi was founded by Pierce alumna and MIT faculty member Angeliki - Artemis Rigos who earned a BA in chemistry from Cornell University, a Ph.D. in physical chemistry from MIT, and an MBA from Northeastern University and has dedicated her career to teaching leadership in STEMM fields. Dr. Rigos piloted Epistimi at ACG in 2023 with 14 international women in STEMM.

Seanergy Maritime Holdings Corp and United Maritime Corporation, both Nasdaq-listed companies, made a joint gift to ACG, a generous multi-year donation of \$43K, funding two partial scholarships for students studying shipping management.

DEREE IMPACT

More Scholarships

ACG thanks the **A.C. Laskaridis Charitable Foundation** for its renewed annual gift of \$16K supporting scholarships in entrepreneurial management.

In response to its success and high student demand for the Latsis Foundation Study Abroad Scholarships, the **John S. Latsis Public Benefit Foundation** has generously extended the scholarship program for three years through 2026 and grown the number of scholarships so that annually 20 - 25 deserving undergraduate Deree students are supported to study abroad at recognized educational institutions worldwide.

A scholarship program was established in 2022 Libra Philanthropies, a private independent foundation launched by Libra Group, that builds on more than a decade of responsibility Libra Group's social philanthropic work. Libra Group, a global ecosystem of businesses with a presence in 60 countries, provides support to students who wish to pursue a Master (MA or MS) at the Deree Graduate School, considering financial need and academic performance.



The **OTE Group**, Greece's largest technology company, is providing scholarships for Deree students pursuing a BSc in Cybersecurity and Networks and an MS in Data Science over two years.

eLearning Industry Inc., a leading publishing platform for eLearning professionals, is providing scholarships to master's degree students in Learning Design and Technology at the Deree Graduate School.

Eurobank Equities Scholarships, Greece's largest broker, provides scholarships to Deree students pursuing a minor in Financial Markets Trading.

Europa Insurance, with their generous donation to the Centennial Fund, will further expand the scholarship support they offer in support of ACG students, leading to positive social and economic change.

SINCE 2012 AND ITS AFFILIATION WITH ACG, ALBA HAS EDUCATED MORE THAN 5K GRADUATE BUSINESS STUDENTS AND TRAINED MORE THAN 15K GREEK BUSINESS PROFESSIONALS ENTREPRENEURS THROUGH EXECUTIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS, HELPING ACCELERATE GREECE'S ECONOMIC RECOVERY.
