Therapies. Reflexology was the modality that attracted her the most so she went on to further training in UK completing the AOR Practitioner Certificate with distinction. She further developed her skills in Reflexology by training in Vertical Reflex Therapy- VRT, Advanced Reflexology Techniques -ART, Hand Reflexology. As an adjunct to Reflexology, she also trained in EFT - Emotional Freedom Technique, Australian Bush Flower Essences. Music and Drama; Master MMus in Historic and Systematic Musicology, National Kapodistrian University of Athens. Effi has been teaching Music History, Music Appreciation, Musical Theater Performance Skills, Issues in Performance, Music in the Community and Applied Singing at ACG since 1998. She is the Music Director the ACG Community Choir. As a lute player she has collaborated with most Greek orchestras and has participated in the performance and the recordings of Handel's "Oreste", "Arianna in Creta" "Tamerlano" (Echo Klassic Award for best recording of 18th c Opera) and "Giulio Cesare" for the German company MDG. As a singer she actively promotes the vocal music of the 16th and 17th centuries. She has recorded a CD entitled "Nativita di Christo" in collaboration with the Music Department of ACG and a CD entitled "Lovely Echoes" in collaboration with SPIZA. In 2018 she recorded a CD of 17th century Italian vocal music entitled Vita Segreta Musica Segreta with the ensemble Canto Soave of which she is a founding member. She has collaborated with the Megaron Athens Concert Hall in the presentation of Sunday Morning Concerts for young listeners, the Friends of the Greek Island and Sea organizing and leading interactive musical workshops for children and adults in various islands, and with the Orchestra and the Choir of the Municipality of Athens planning and presenting their educational program.

Christina Mylona Pioneer Traditional Dairy Producer, Kamena Vourla

Christina was born in 1939 and has been a pioneer in the artisanal dairy tradition of Central Greece. In 1958, she and her husband loannis Mylonas opened the first dairy shop in Kamena Vourla, crafting fresh yogurt, rice

pudding, chocolate milk, butter and more by hand using a large cauldron and open flame. Their family business quickly expanded, supplying over 1,000 rice puddings per week to local summer camps and having exclusive partnerships with the Lamia dairy factory. Prestigious hotels such as Galini Mitsis, Thronio, and Radio relied on their products, including whipped cream, yogurt, rice puddings and traditional milk butter. They also supplied the regional summer camp with rice pudding and distributed products throughout the villages. The business operated until around 1984, leaving behind a legacy of dedication, craftsmanship, and authentic Greek flavor that shaped the region's food culture for decades.

Chrisilia Faki Sound Healer/ Art Psychotherapist/ Artist

With an inherited talent on expressive arts as a graduate from Pierce College, she initially trained as a Graphic Designer at London College of Printing and as an Art Psychotherapist at Goldsmiths University of London.

She practiced with children and adults in schools and mental health institutes in the UK and in Greece. Healing Arts, also shaped her own self-awareness and personal healing. Her clay works became the art containers where sound echoed itself as the unseen vessel on how to hold nurturing space for herself. She explored sound healing at the British Academy of Sound Therapy, UK and qualified as a Crystal Bowl Practitioner at the Sound University of London. She partnered with yoga studios and corporate wellbeing events until she became an ASM Practitioner with Sara Auster in NY, practicing sound and sensing through deep intentional listening, presence and compassion. She currently lives in Greece and creates spaces for immersive sound bath experiences, using the Auster Sound Method inviting audiences into deeper ways of being for connection reflection and healing.
