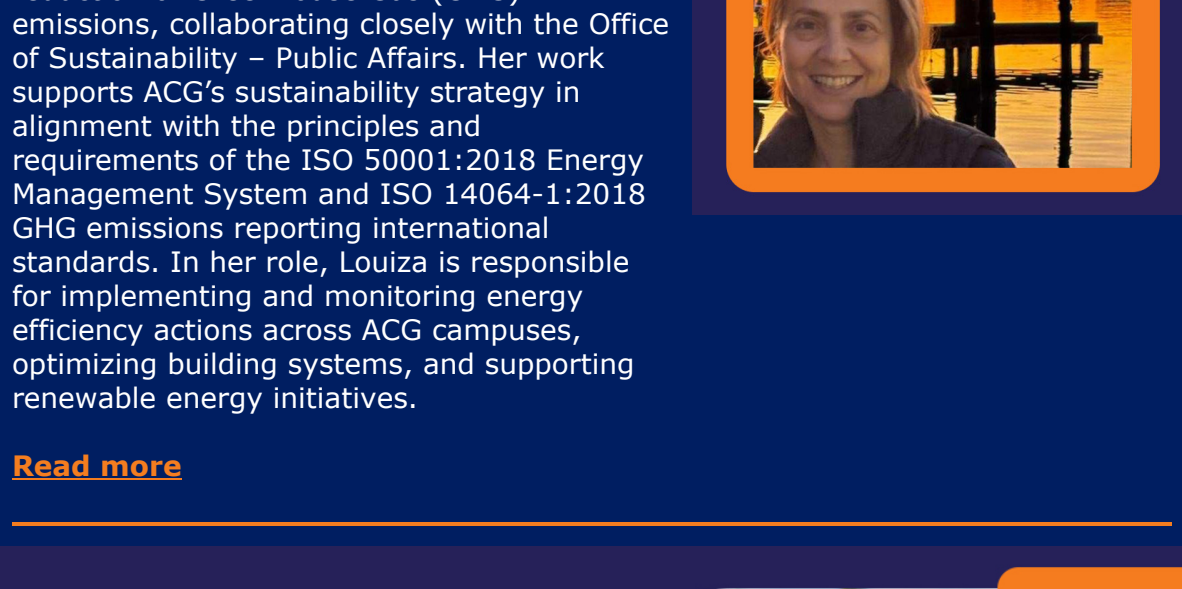
The event will be open to the public.

Bring your own reusable cup or bottle
