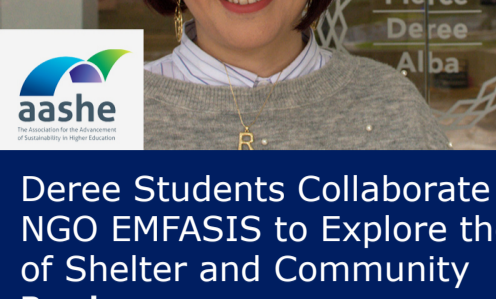

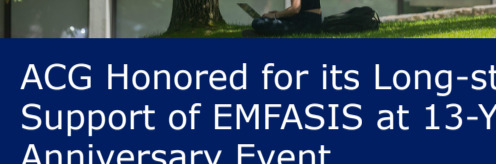

Barbara Margarita Radmann

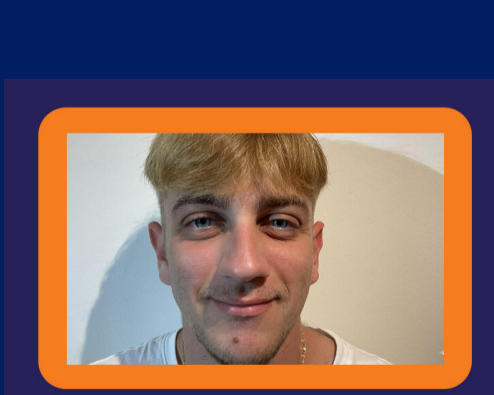
